


Workshop Requirements




2. Set up a new site

Please follow the steps below to get your environment ready for the "Building an AMP Compatible WordPress Site" workshop at WordCamp Sevilla. By doing that in advance, you can get the most out of the workshop, since it will allow you to directly follow along on your own computer. Plus, you will have the environment also for later explorations based on what you've learned.

The steps below describe everything you need to do in detail, but if you like, there is also visual slide deck you can look at in addition.


1. Install Local by Flywheel

Download Local by Flywheel and install it on your machine.

2. Set up a new site

Start Local by Flywheel, and create a new site by clicking on the small + icon in the lower left corner. You can give your site any name you like, and ignore all the other configuration options. For username and password, you can choose something

5. SSH into the new site's Docker container



6. Run the downloaded script

(This will take a few minutes based on your network connection. You will be prompted to configure your git username and email. Don't worry if you see some warnings during script execution, it should be fine.)
